A shopping centre

Council - Reserves (General)

Keep some of the greenspaces safe from alteration eg car parks, etc

Clean weeds from reserve in Waterview

Maintain and restore the few reserves we have

Better upkeep (for) Lynley Park reserve

More reserves and green spaces

Council - Domain/Esplanade/Parking/Boat Ramp

Protection mechanisms could be part of playground, community education project. Could create a space on the beach, going into the water

Keep lullaby at beach playground

Beachfront reserve; move bollards in so room for more parking on side

A proper plan for the esplanade needs to be put into place ASAP. There will be fights on the boat ramp at this rate

Better playground for children in Domain. We must have oldest playground equipment in NZ. Totally old fashioned. We need more modern playground

New playground and slides and everything like msn

Add family park and kayak access to point reserve – picnic tables etc

Keep waterfront iconic kiwi beach style

How is the waterfront going to accommodate the increase of residents? Don't spoil the waterfront – limit more expansion

Preserve the beach area by controlling grass growth over the sand. The beach is getting less and less along the domain and esplanade.

Height restriction on buildings near the beach

Better control of dogs along the domain and esplanade. Many dogs are not on leads and out of control on domain beach

All dogs on lead in Domain area. Pick up poo.

Boat ramp needs to be widened next to existing ramp. Due to bigger community , more boats, = congestion at moment, no room for extra boats being launched

Boat launching – better all tide ramp more parking wider ramp

Ban all camper caravans from boat trailer park. Put them in Cooney reserve

Camper vans are not the problem. Cars parked over several days are where trailers should be

Deal with parking at Domain. Long term Matakana parking elsewhere

Parking is an issue. Better organising and enforcement needed.

Extra parking needs to be addressed. Specific area allocated for Matakana residents. Running out of car boat trailer space. No room for picnickers.

Parking needs to be freed up, the limits and policed. Boat trailer parking for boats and trailers only. Motor caravans limited to the stated rules. Max 3 vans etc

Carpark for people leaving parked cars near the boat ramp all week when they go to Matakana island by ferry.

More parking can be created along driveway to Sea Scouts hall

Boat trailer carparking only at the carpark next to the store

Increase carpark at Domain more at Crapps end of beach

Restrict the number of motor homes parking on the esplanade. Better still have no vans parked in the car park.

Parking for those going to Matakana needs sorting out. Cars are left on the esplanade all day by people going to Matakana
